Shattered Hopes

- Most disciples fled
 - Mark 14:50 “Then everyone deserted him and fled”.
- Watched from a distance
 - Luke 23:49 “All those who knew him, including the women who had followed him from Galilee, stood at a distance, watching”
- John alone...
- Feared to even ask for his body

Wait A Minute !?!

- Ladies on their way to the tomb
 - Luke 24
- Suddenly Jesus meets them
 - Matthew 28:9
- John first disciple to arrive, then Peter
 - John 20:3-7
- Jesus begins to appear
 - Mary Magdalene, Road to Emmaus, the disciples, Thomas, on a fishing trip

It's Not Over!

- The resurrection becomes the turning point, for the disciples, for the world
 - Main message of the preaching
 - Acts 2:23-24 & 37-39
 - “Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved”.
